Community

The villages of Stewardson and Strasburg are located in south central Illinois on Highway 32. The two communities have a total population of approximately 1,350 residents. The main economic base for both communities is agriculture.

School District

The school is three miles north of Stewardson and three miles south of Strasburg, and the school building faces Highway 32. The entire district, Pre-K through 12, is housed in one building. In 1951 the communities of Stewardson and Strasburg consolidated to form the current high school. In 1969 the elementary wing was built, adjoining the high school. The junior high wing was added in 1996. The school is approximately 100 miles east of St. Louis, Missouri, 200 miles south of Chicago, Illinois, 72 miles south of the University of Illinois, and 30 miles southwest of Eastern Illinois University. It is in the Lake Land Junior College District.

Stewardson-Strasburg High School

The student population currently consists of 106 students. Faculty and administration consist of 15 teachers, one guidance counselor, one principal, and one athletic director.

Period Scheduling

Classes are scheduled on a straight 8-period day, with each class being 46 minutes long.

Graduation Requirements

- P.E. is required yearly. It will count as 1/2 credit per year and will count in figuring GPA.

Grading System

Stewardson-Strasburg High School operates on a 5.0 Grade Point System with an "A+" being the highest grade achievable. The class of 2020 and beyond will be on a 4.0 grading scale.

To find a student's Grade Point Average (GPA), add all grade points of all classes taken and divide by the total possible credits for all courses taken.
